A is an organizational subunit of B	<i>Department—Store</i> <i>Maintenance—Airline</i>
A uses or manages or owns B	<i>Cashier—Register</i> <i>Player—Piece</i> <i>Pilot—Airplane</i>
A is next to B	<i>SalesLineItem—SalesLineItem</i> <i>Square—Square</i> <i>City—City</i>
